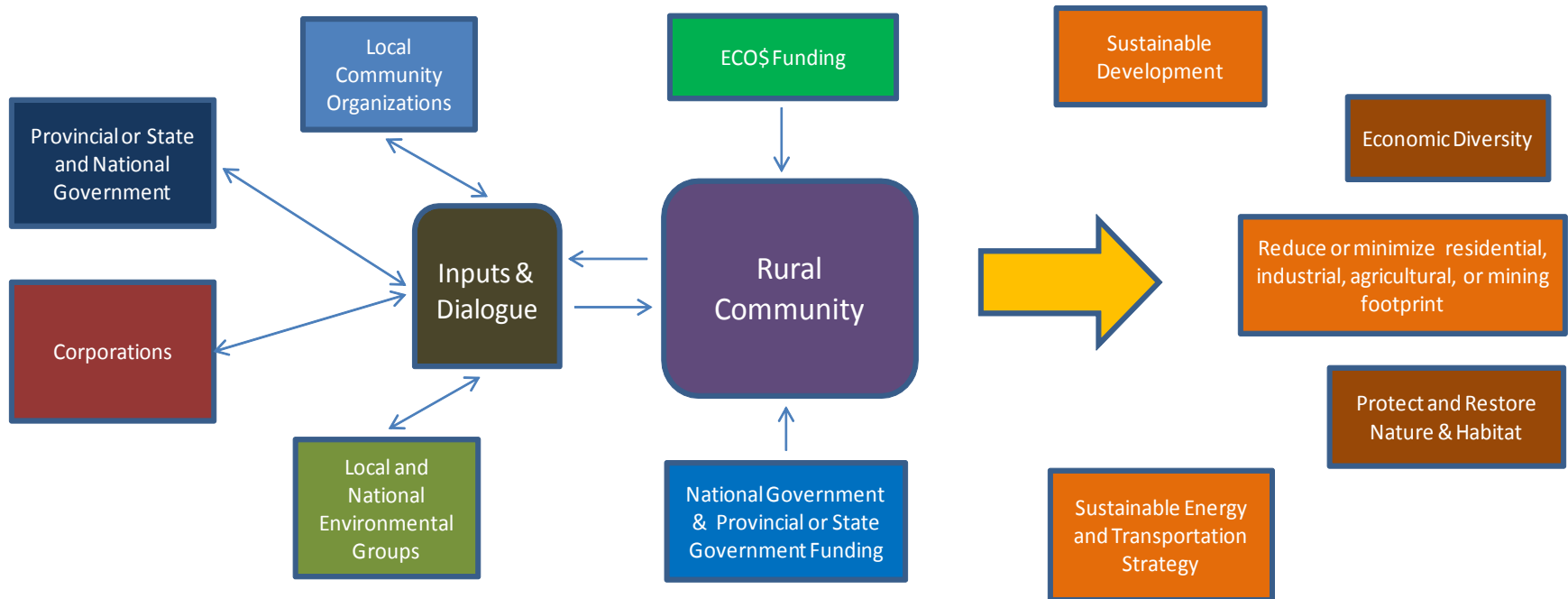

Rural, Agricultural, Industrial, and Mining Sustainability

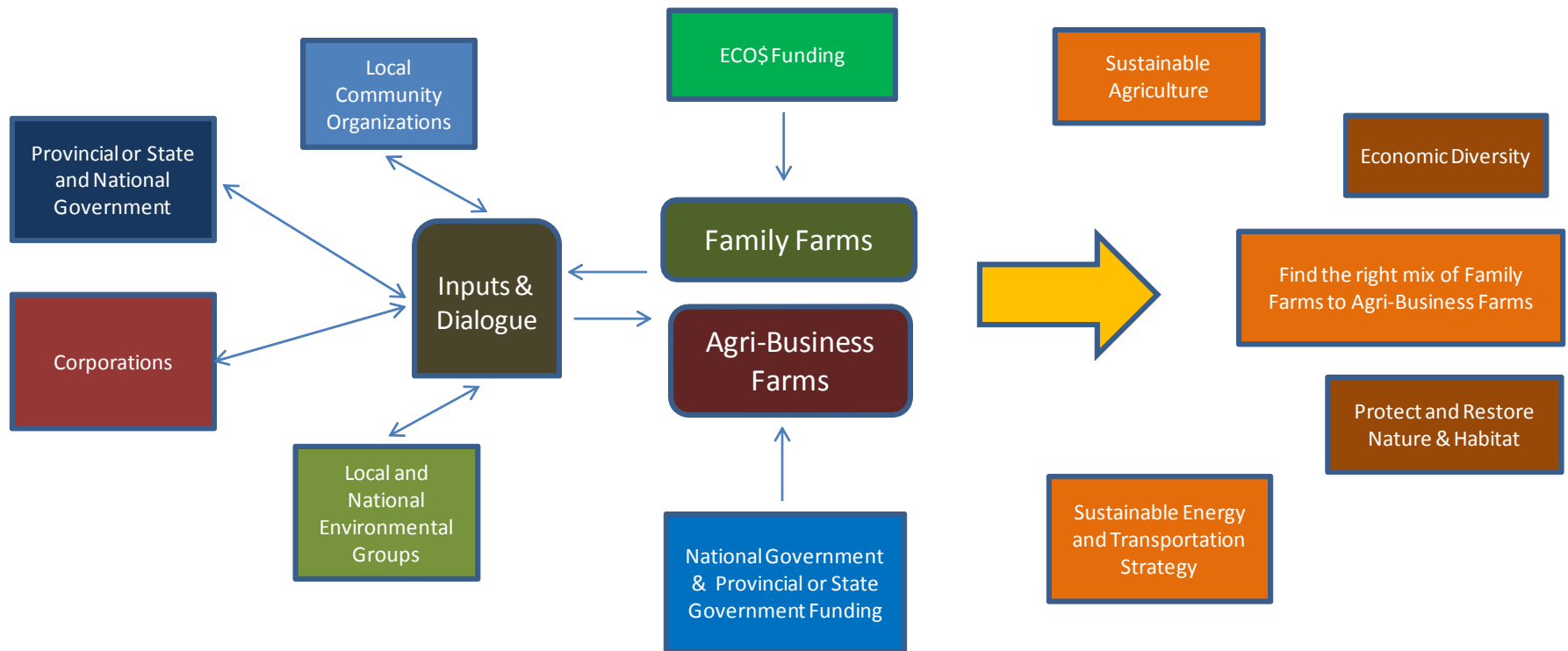

Rural Communities Transition to Sustainability



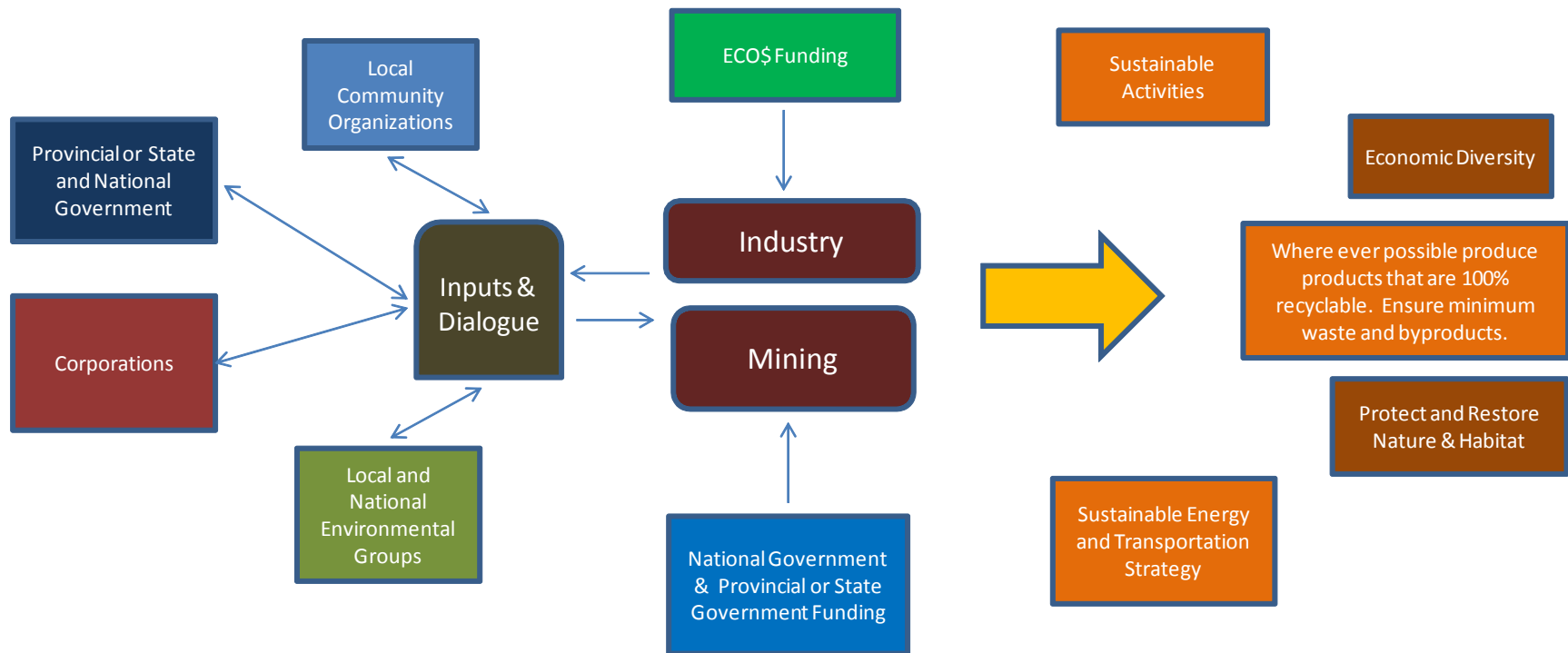
Rural Agriculture Transition to Sustainability
